### Jean Monnet Projects

The European Studies Master's Program is one of the few European Studies programs where there are three ongoing Jean Monnet course modules and three Jean Monnet chairs. In addition, the program is included in the LISBOAN Network (Linking Interdisciplinary Integration Studies by Broadening the European Academic Network) in 2010. The European Commission recognized the excellence in teaching and research conducted within the program with a Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence award-SUCEES in 2011. The program's inclusion into the European Commission's Jean Monnet project through these grants is a further illustration of its competitive strength internationally.
